Sarah is in charge of the staff and students at the Walker Building but there are lots of staff who lend a hand



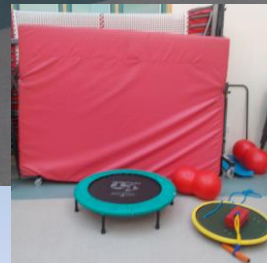
There is a board in reception to tell you which staff are in and which staff are out.



There are also lots of maps around the building to help you find your way around.



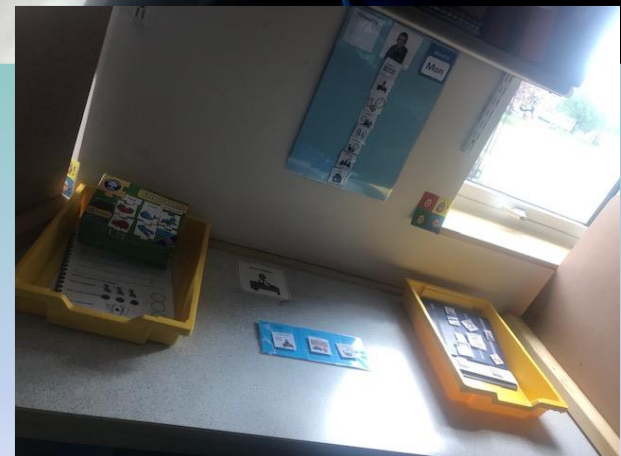
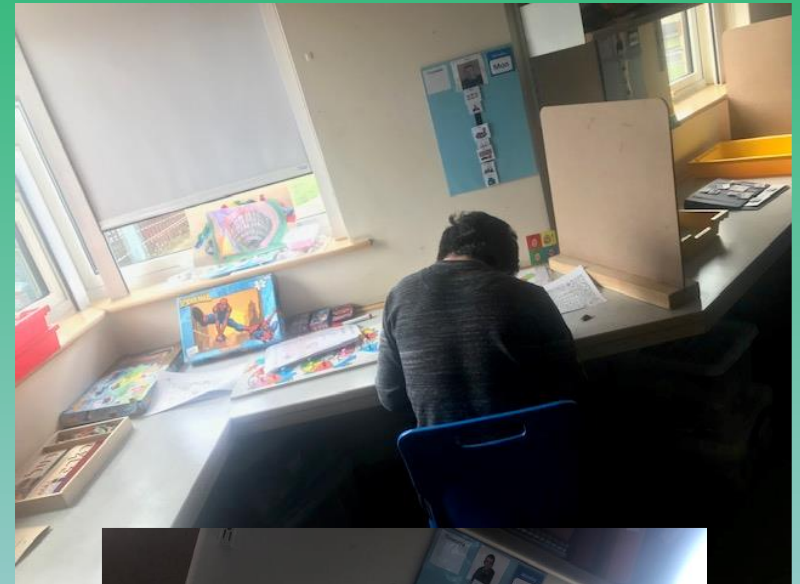
The Hall is in the centre of the Walker Building. You will eat your lunch here. There is a noticeboard with pictures to help you choose your lunch

This is Walker 3. Ainsley Cole is the teacher who uses this classroom.



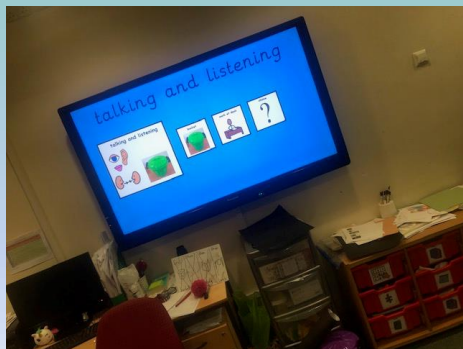
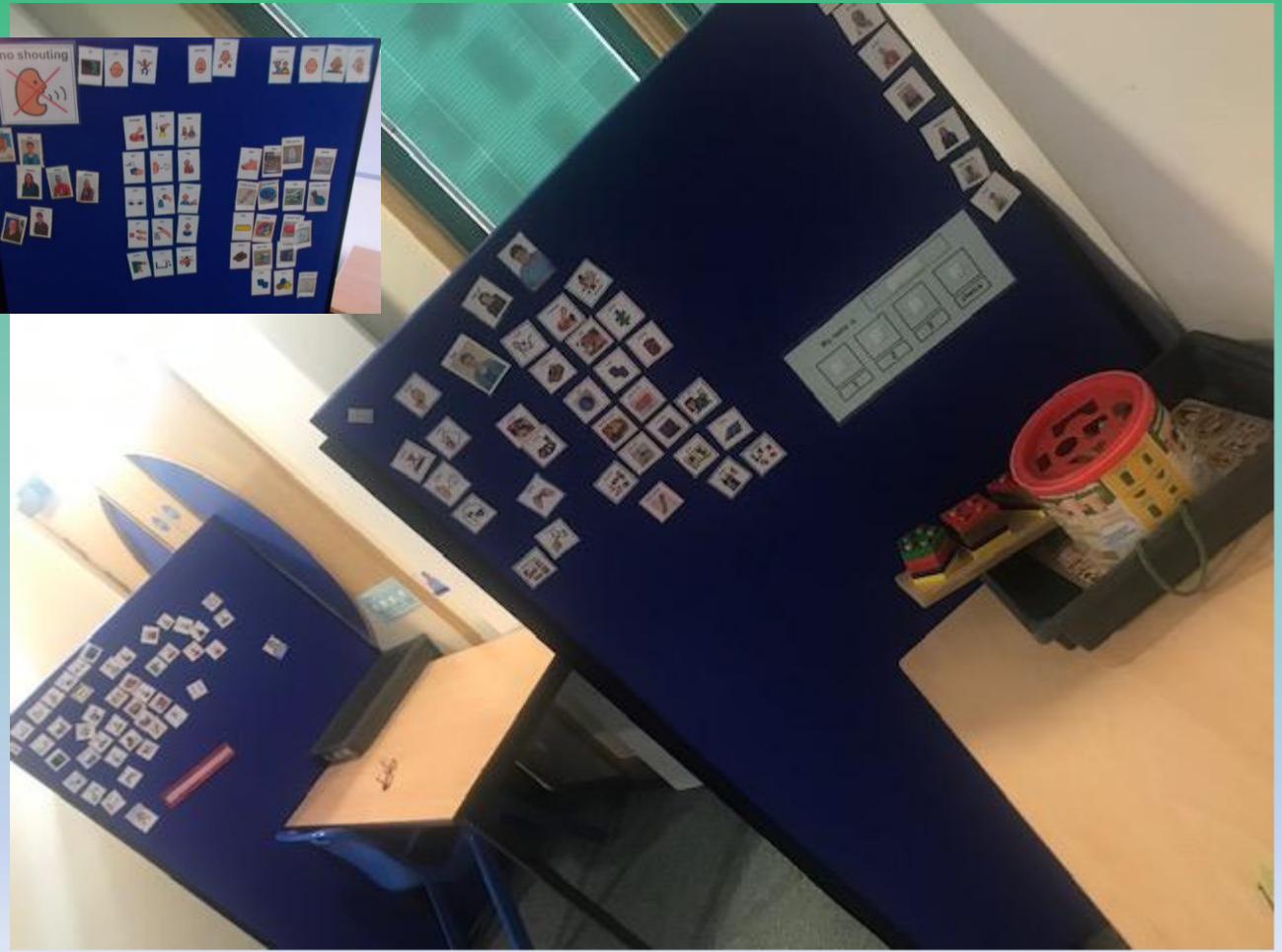
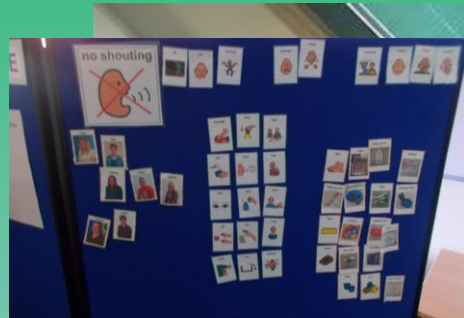
This is Walker 4. Jade is the teacher who uses this classroom

In each of the classrooms, there are lots of signs and symbols to help keep you on task and help you if you get stuck with something.



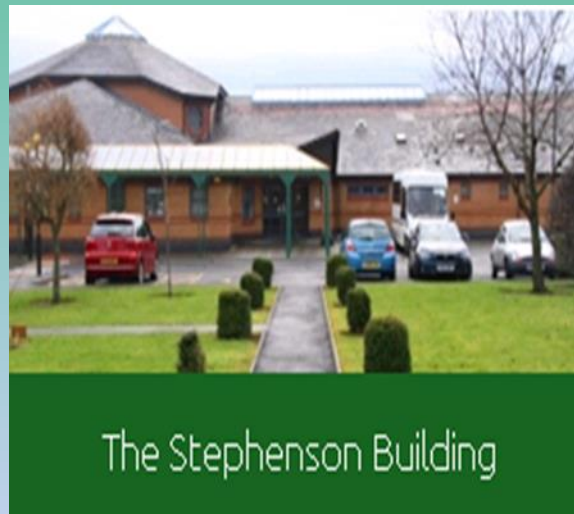
The Sensory room is used by any student who needs a sensory break in their day. There are lots of things to rock, swing or bounce on
