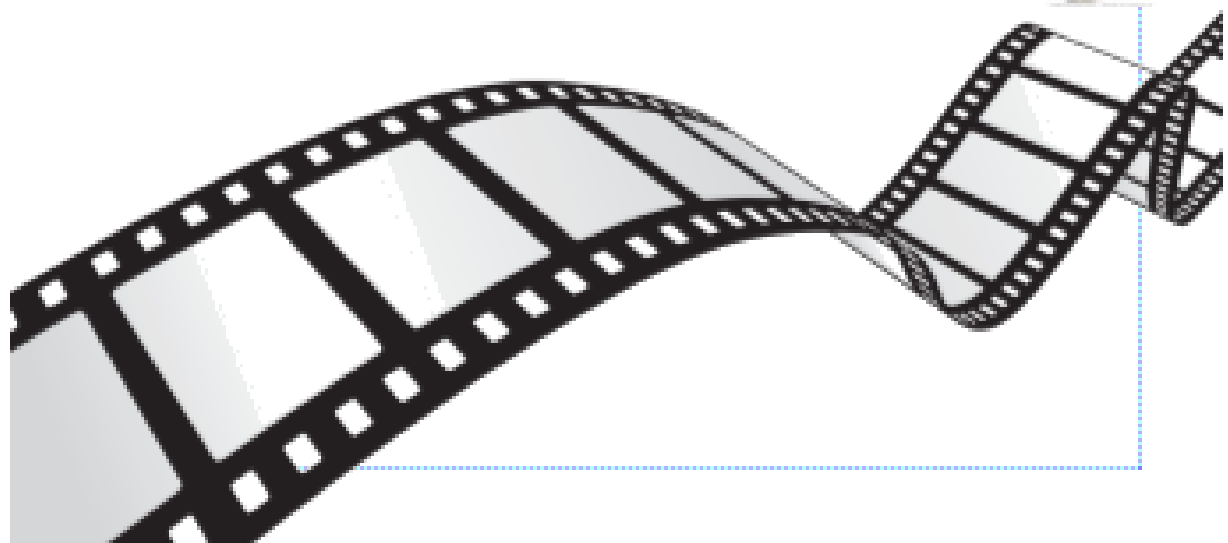
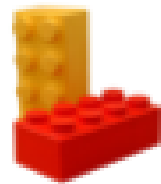
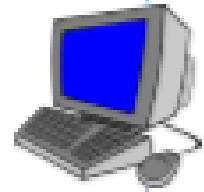

**All week day clubs are from 3.15pm-5.15pm term time only and are £10 per session.**





All clubs are on site in either the Walker building, Sheraton Building or the Stephenson Building.




