Outerwear		Hoodies, jackets, coats, hats and scarfs can be worn: • Breaktime • Lunchtime • To and from lessons if they are in another building.
Make-up		We will allow an application of light foundation, but excessive make up, fake tan and additions such as false nails/eyelashes/hair extensions are not appropriate within the school setting and should not be worn by students.
Jewellery		Whilst we are happy for students to wear a single or a small pair of studs in their ears, we don't allow students to have other piercings such as nose or tongue. If you allow your child to have one of these piercings then they will be asked to remove it whilst in school for health and safety reasons.
Mobile phones		We would prefer that students do not bring mobile phones into school but appreciate that some students do independently travel to and from school and for those students, this is an essential item. If a student does bring a mobile phone into school it must be handed into Reception on arrival and collected from there at the end of the school day. Parents/carers and students must sign a Mobile Phone agreement and abide by the rules stated in this.
